Kateri Tekakwitha, who was a Mohawk Indian born in upstate New York in 1656, embraced Catholicism after smallpox left her disfigured, partially blinded and without a family. She then went to live with her uncle, the Mohawk Chief. Known as the "Lily of the Mohawks" for her heroic suffering, St. Kateri remained the embodiment of beauty and peace as she shined the love of Jesus. She is the patron saint of ecology, the environment, Indigenous peoples, and those ridiculed for their piety. Her feast day is celebrated on July 14.
